

Please welcome our new artist to the RGM roster.....**Tommy O'Sullivan** from County Kerry, Ireland.

Tommy is acclaimed as "*one of the great contemporary folk voices of Ireland*".

He has toured throughout North America and Europe, appearing at many major venues and festivals. He also tours with Sliabh Notes with Paddy Keenan and Donal Murphy in a more traditional setting.

However, what attracted RGM to Tommy O'Sullivan was his own album "**Song Ablaze**" which features a much wider range of music, from traditional Irish and American music, to bluesy and contemporary interpretations of some of the best songs from both worlds. Tommy, a fine writer in his own stead, shines with how he presents other's material, and in fact his choice of what songs to perform shows impeccable taste and understanding of the possibilities of the music.

His vocal depth and resonance, brilliant guitar work, and tasty choice of interpreting the music left us with no doubt that he would do well for our roster.

A strong male vocal was the one area we felt we could still use on our very strong Celtic roster, and was something we have been on the lookout for, and Tommy was just the right fit.

In addition he will be touring with a strong band, including **Nicky Scott** on upright bass, long time bass player for *Van Morrison* and such other artists such as the Mary Black Band and Gilbert O'Sullivan. **Aoife Granville** from Dingle, Co. Kerry, on Piano, flute and fiddle, who has performed for many Kerry and Dublin Orchestras and fiddle group Fiddlesticks. She has won many awards including the prestigious Senior Flute title in 2003 and has a PhD in Ethnomusicology. Rounding out the quartet is a wonderful new-comer, **Sandra O'Sullivan** doing Backing Vocals.

This quartet format will be touring starting from Summer and Fall 2010, onward to February/March 2011.

Tommy will also be open for **select solo performances**, with guitar/vocals, these mainly on either ends of the quartet band tours. This is a great option for smaller venues that can do a solo artist format.
